We are very honoured that Slava Grigoryan, Director of the Adelaide International Guitar Festival, has agreed to conclude the series with a solo recital.

As in previous years, I expect these concerts will sell quickly so I am particularly pleased that a number of our artists have agreed to give two performances. This enables more patrons to enjoy our unique musical offering in the Adelaide Hills.

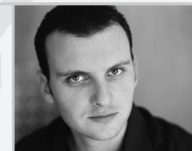
